Our Cadetship Program

Our Cadetship Program

As a business, we take great pride in nurturing our team members and supporting the next generation of leaders. We are very excited to be launching our Cadetship Program in January 2026, to give university and TAFE students the opportunity to gain hands-on experience across four key areas of construction:

- Project Management
- Contracts Administration
- Estimating & Pre-Construction
- Site Management

The main focus of our program is to nurture future Project Managers, Contracts Administrators and Estimators, who have a wholistic view of residential construction, including how things operate in an on-site environment. The Site Management aspect of the program is aimed at providing insight into this area of construction.

This 11-month program will be facilitated by experts in their respective fields, with content that is real, practical and aims to give our Cadets a true experience of working on a Cadence & Co project.

Cadets will be on a Fixed-Term Employment Contract for the 11-month period. This would move to a standard Permanent Employment Contract if an ongoing position is offered at the completion of the Cadetship program.





Our Unique Cadetship Experience

As a high-end residential builder, our Cadetship Program offers a unique opportunity not typically found in this area of construction. We are proud to provide hands-on experience and mentorship for students eager to break into the luxury homebuilding space—focusing on bespoke, architecturally designed residences rather than large-scale commercial developments.

If you're seeking a long-term career with an established company in the luxury residential sector, this is your chance to stand out.

Number of placements

We anticipate 2-4 Cadet placements will be offered for the 2026 cohort.

While this program is new to us in 2026, as a company, Cadence & Co has a proven history in supporting the growth and opportunity of our team members, and we are ready to take our development to the next level.

By investing in our people, we are building a strong legacy for us as a business and for the individual careers of our people.



Availability

Prospective Cadets should be entering their final year of study in early 2026, and available to work at Cadence & Co 3-4 days per week (depending on their university/TAFE timetables) and then full time during the university/TAFE holidays.

Cadets will be given opportunity to take leave for study or exams as needed.

Depending on the placement area, working hours may vary from 9am-5pm or 7am-3pm based on project requirements. The Cadets should be flexible to accommodate the area of the company they are placed in.

This paid Cadetship will be based on an hourly rate, giving the flexibility to meet the changing requirements of the Cadet and their studies.

Please note this program is not suitable for international students. We are looking for Cadets who are wanting a long-term career with Cadence & Co, and we cannot offer sponsorship. Therefore, it is only suitable for Australian Citizens or Permanent Residents.

Location and Travel Requirements

The program will be facilitated from our studio in Terrey Hills, as well as on-site around the Northern Beaches and North Shore area of Sydney.

Cadets are expected to be flexible and willing to travel to a variety of project sites, as well as our main studio. In order to travel to these various locations, Cadets are required to hold a current driver's license and drive their own vehicle.





Support & Evaluation

To ensure each Cadet feels supported during their time with us, a Buddy will be allocated to each Cadet. This will not necessarily be someone involved in their training, but someone they can go to for daily questions/support as needed.

Cadets can check in with their Buddy anytime they need, and structured catch ups are also encouraged to support this relationship.

Our leaders who are part of the Cadetship Project Team can also be approached at any time for support.

There will also be a number of formal and informal evaluations at various times throughout the program, to ensure the success of the individuals and the program overall. This will also include performance reviews following the end of each Stream, as well as discussions with the People & Culture Team regarding the areas they are interested in exploring further.

Post Program Employment

Following completion of the program, the intention is to offer permanent employment positions to the Cadets who have proven themselves to be high performers, and who are suitable in both their technical capabilities and their personal attributes.

Ongoing opportunities are offered based on suitability and project requirements. Permanent placements are not guaranteed.

Program Timeline

In summary, the overall Cadetship Program timeline is as follows:

- Applications close 30 September 2025
- Shortlisting and interviews - October 2025
- Offers - November-December 2025
- Start Date - January 2026
- Completion - December 2026



Selection Process

To ensure selection of the best candidates, applicants will go through a thorough selection process, which will include:

Application form

Including submission of relevant supporting material

2-minute video submission

As part of your application, we ask that you record a short 2-minute video telling us why you're interested in joining Cadence & Co.

This isn't a big deal – it's simply a chance for us to get a feel for who you are beyond your Application Form. And to help us understand your enthusiasm and fit for the program. Feel free to be yourself – we're not looking for perfection, just personality.

Meet & Mingle at Cadence

Shortlist candidates will be invited to attend an informal event at the Cadence & Co studio, to mingle with some of our Cadence & Co team members. The purpose of this session is for us to get to know you, and for you to get to know us, in a relaxed and open setting. You will have the opportunity to chat to and ask questions of some of our senior leaders, as well as other up and coming Cadence & Co team members.

Formal interviews

Each candidate would also be invited to a formal interview with nominated senior leaders. This may be followed by second round interviews if required.

Cadetship Curriculum



Cadetship Curriculum

As part of the Cadetship Program, you will rotate through various areas of the business to give you an all-round view of construction at Cadence & Co.

Please note: The below topics and timings are an estimate and may change in line with team/project requirements.

Induction, Onboarding and Safety (1 week)

- Company overview and key projects presentations
- Overview of Estimating, Contracts Administration and Project Management at Cadence & Co
- Meet department teams and Cadet mentors
- Site tours and safety inductions with Safety Manager

Intro to Site Management (1 week)

All Cadets will do an initial 1-week Site Management placement to provide exposure to the on-site environment. They could touch on any of the below topics during this time:

- Understand safety protocols, daily routines and documentation on site
- Learn how subcontractors are managed day-to-day and how to communicate effectively with trades
- Understand how site logistics are planned and monitored against project timelines
- Learn about quality control, defects management and professional conduct on-site
- Maintain and update site signage / noticeboards
- Assist with materials check-in and site deliveries
- Help with compiling site photos and reports
- Support in preparing for inspections (certifier or client)

Stream A - Contracts Admin (12 weeks):

- Systems training: BuilderTrend, MS Projects, Blue Beam, Excel etc.
- Understanding contract types
- Tendering and procurement - issuing RFI's and evaluating quotes
- Subcontractor onboarding - compliance, insurances, and scopes
- Purchase orders and variations - issuing, tracking and approvals
- Progress claims and invoicing - validating and processing payments
- Contract compliance - ensuring obligations are met
- Document control - managing drawings, specs, and correspondence
- Dispute resolution basics - handling claims and conflicts professionally
- Attend site meetings and progress claims review
- Formal performance review at completion of stream



Stream B - Project Management (12 weeks):

- Systems training: BuilderTrend, MS Projects, Blue Beam, Excel etc.
- Project lifecycle overview - from pre-construction to handover
- Scheduling and programming - using tools like MS Project or Buildertrend
- Site coordination - managing trades, deliveries and daily activities
- Budget tracking - monitoring costs and forecasting
- Client communication - updates, meetings and managing expectations
- Quality assurance - inspections, checklists, and defect management
- Risk and issue management - identifying and resolving site challenges
- Reporting - progress updates, site diaries and project dashboards
- Attend site meetings and progress claims review
- Formal performance review at completion of stream

Stream C - Estimating / Pre-Construction (12 weeks):

- Systems training: Cubit
- Learn quantity take-offs, scope breakdowns, and tender reviews
- Sit in on subcontractor pricing and value engineering sessions
- Participate in proposal preparation
- Assist with tender queries and documentation compliance
- Formal performance review at completion of stream

Continue Site Management (2 weeks)

All Cadets to do a 2-week Site Management placement at the end of their Streams to further develop their on-site exposure. They could touch on any of the below topics during this time:

- Understand safety protocols, daily routines and documentation on site
- Learn how subcontractors are managed day-to-day and how to communicate effectively with trades
- Understand how site logistics are planned and monitored against project timelines
- Learn about quality control, defects management and professional conduct on-site
- Maintain and update site signage / noticeboards
- Assist with materials check-in and site deliveries
- Help with compiling site photos and reports
- Support in preparing for inspections (certifier or client)

Final Phase (8 weeks)

- Assigned to a live project
- Take on greater independence on tasks (e.g. managing procurement for a package)
- Responsibility building
- Involvement in a "special project" as allocated by the Exec Team or Department Leads
- Prepare a short project reflection or presentation to leadership team

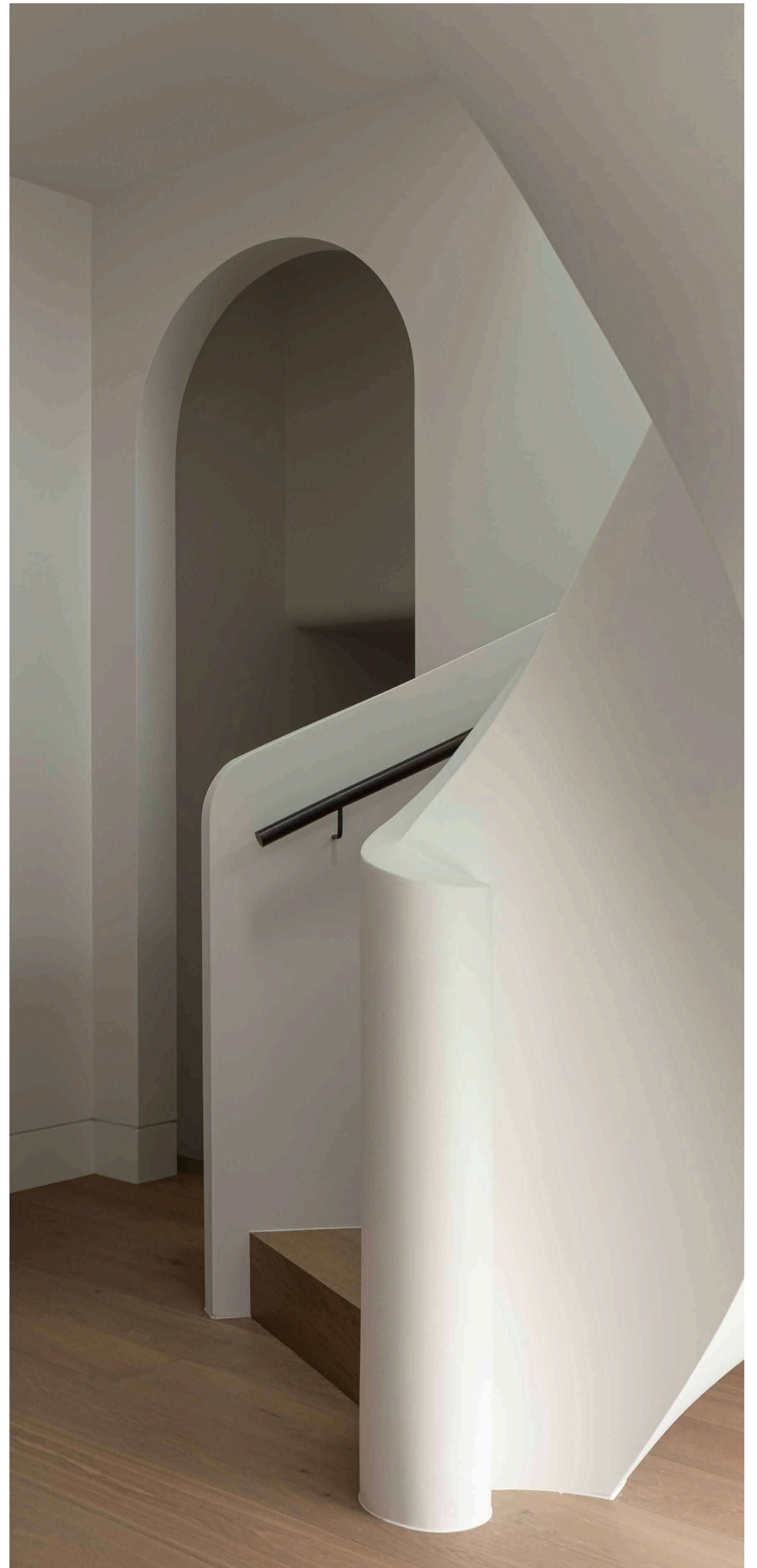

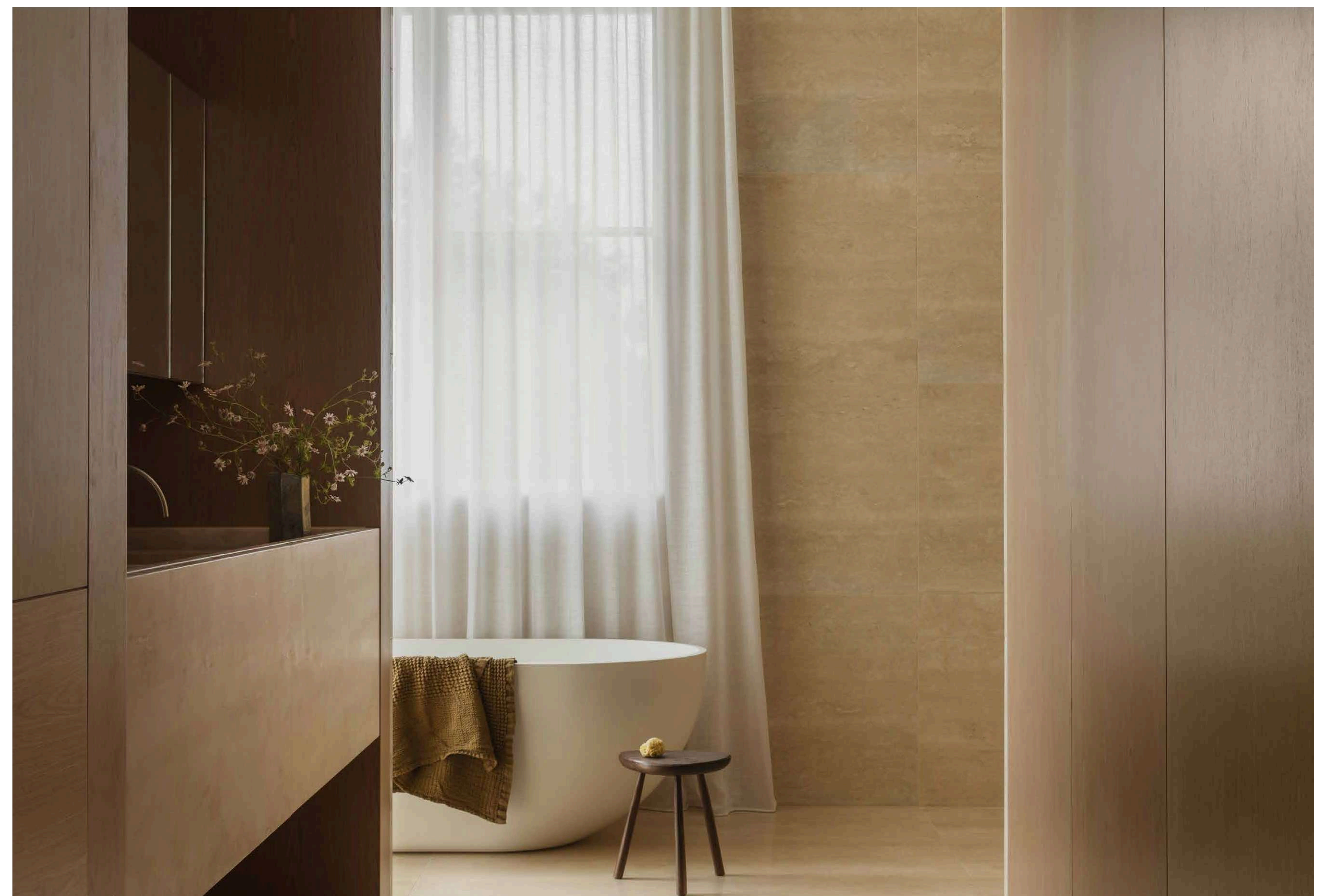
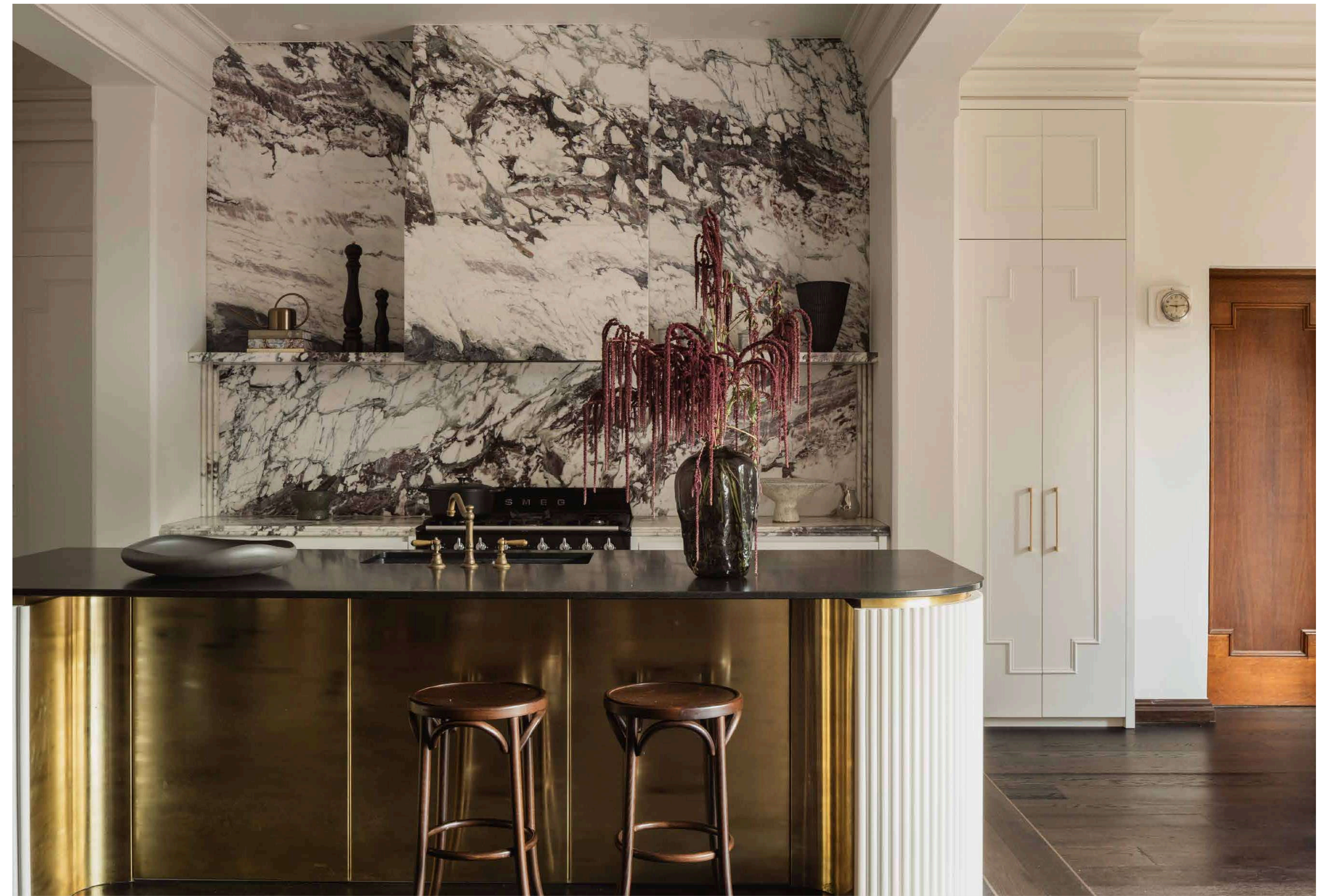
